

Tuition Project

In 2010, PERTIWI launched the Tuition Project in two areas. The project that started at the Ar-Rahman Mosque in Kampung Tunku, Petaling Jaya, in January 2010 involved 97 students. They were the children of Kampung Tunku and its surrounding areas, especially those from families earning RM3000.00 and below.

Financial contributions for this project, aside from PERTIWI, were also obtained from the Japan Club of Kuala Lumpur. On 3 July 2010, seven Committee members from this Club paid a visit to the tuition classes, and found the course of the project to be satisfactory.

The tuition project at the Sri Pantai Secondary School, Kampung Kerinchi, Kuala Lumpur started in April 2010. It was specifically for students sitting for the major school examinations of PMR and SPM. Funds for this project were from the Federal Territory Islamic Council (Federal Territory Baitulmal).
